

ACI Shotcrete Inspector Certification requires the successful completion of the following three components, within a one-year time period:

1. ACI Shotcrete Inspector two-hour, open book, written exam.
2. ACI Concrete Field Testing Technician – Grade I written exam *or* current certification in either:
 - a. ACI Concrete Field Testing Technician – Grade I
 - b. ACI CSA-Standards Field Testing Technician
 - c. CCIL Basic Concrete Field Type QF Technician
3. Three-years shotcrete related education/work experience

Successful completion of items 1 & 2 above, within one year, results in an **ACI Associate Shotcrete Inspector Certification**, allowing five years to successfully complete item #3 to upgrade to ACI Shotcrete Inspector Certification. ASA Inspector Education aka *Quality Shotcrete – Know it When You See It* (7 hours)
